

HOLMES STREET DECORATIVE FENCE REPLACEMENT

FEBRUARY 2025 PROJECT UPDATE

WHAT IS THE CITY DOING?

The Holmes Street fence is more than 60 years old and in need of improvement. This 1,400 foot long stretch of fence includes brick pillars that are leaning and have potential for failure. This project will install a new 7-foot tall painted redwood fence in place of the existing one that should last 30 years for residents. This project is funded by the City's General Fund for Existing Asset Maintenance and Repair and is estimated to cost approximately \$450,000 to complete.

WHAT ARE THE IMPACTS?

Construction Schedule: Project to begin February and is expected to be completed Spring 2025.

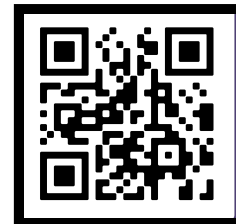
Construction Hours: Lane closure along Holmes Street and construction noise expected between **7:00AM-3:30PM**. See project map on back.

Tree & Bush Trimmings: Minor pruning for trees and bushes which extend beyond or are up against the Holmes Street fence shall occur as the contractor installs and paints the new fence.
