

## PUBLIC NOTICE

This is to advise that the Livermore City Council will conduct a public hearing at its meeting of May 11, 2026, beginning at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as may be heard, to consider the matter listed below:

Hearing to consider the City of Livermore's U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Fiscal Year 2026-27 Action Plan for HOME Investment Partnership and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funding ("FY 2026-27 Action Plan"). A public comment period will begin on April 10, 2026, and will end on May 11, 2026, to solicit public comments.

The City invites public comment on the matter with the following formats available:

1. Written comments are to be submitted prior to the meeting by using e-comment (on website) until 4:00 p.m., by emailing [cityclerk@livermoreca.gov](mailto:cityclerk@livermoreca.gov) by 12:00 p.m. or by delivering to the City Clerk at 1052 S Livermore Ave by 12:00 p.m. the day of the meeting.
2. In-person comments may be provided at the Civic Center Meeting Hall, City Council Chamber, 1016 S. Livermore Avenue, Livermore, CA 94550.

Public comments are limited to 3 minutes; and the Mayor may reduce the amount of time based on the number of persons wishing to speak.

Staff report and recommendation will be available for review in the City Council agenda packet from the evening of May 5, 2026, which can be found on the City of Livermore website at [www.livermoreca.gov/agenda](http://www.livermoreca.gov/agenda). Written information regarding these agenda items must be received in the City Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m. on May 4, 2026, to be included in the agenda packet. Materials submitted after the 5:00 p.m. Monday deadline will be given to the City Council the night of the meeting, provided the materials are received in the City Clerk's Office by 12:00 p.m. on the day of the Council meeting.

If you challenge the item in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, or in written correspondence delivered at, or prior to, the public hearing. Note: if these actions are subject to the Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.5, and you choose to challenge these actions in court, you must

seek judicial review within the time specified in the Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.6.

#### PROVISIONS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

If any person with an interest in participating in the hearing and is a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to participate, that person can arrange an accommodation by contacting the ADA coordinator at [adacoordinator@livermoreca.gov](mailto:adacoordinator@livermoreca.gov) or calling (925) 960-4170 (voice) or (925) 960-4104 (TDD). If notified at least two business days in advance of the hearing, the City will arrange to have an interpreter, reader, or aide available as needed. Please notify the City at least five business days before the meeting to request any other reasonable accommodations that may be necessary.

#### PROVISIONS FOR NON-ENGLISH SPEAKING RESIDENTS

The City of Livermore has a network of multi-lingual employees who can act as interpreters for residents seeking information regarding CDBG programs. If notified at least five business days in advance of the hearing that non-English speaking residents wish to participate in the hearing, the City will arrange to have an interpreter available.
