

Notice of Public Hearings on the City of Livermore Proposed 2025 Urban Water Management Plan and Proposed 2025 Water Shortage Contingency Plan

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the public, customers and stakeholders that the Livermore City Council will conduct two public hearings at its meeting on **June 22, 2026 at 7:00 p.m.** to consider the matter listed below. City Council meetings are held in the Civic Center Meeting Hall, City Council Chamber located at 1016 S. Livermore Avenue.

As required by the Urban Water Management Planning Act, California Water Code, sections 10610 through 10657 (“UWMP Act”), this is to notify the public that at its meeting to begin at 7 p.m. on June 22, 2026, the City Council of the City of Livermore plans to conduct public hearings on, and consider adoption of, the City’s proposed 2025 Urban Water Management Plan (“2025 UWMP”) and the City’s proposed 2025 Water Shortage Contingency Plan (“2025 WSCP”). The proposed 2025 UWMP was prepared pursuant to the requirements of the UWMP Act and City of Livermore Municipal Code, Chapter 13.26, and updates the City’s 2020 Urban Water Management Plan adopted pursuant to City Resolution No. 2021-090. The purpose of the public hearing will be to solicit public comment prior to adoption of the proposed updated 2025 UWMP and WSCP.

The City invites public comment on the matter with the following formats available:

1. Written comments are to be submitted prior to the City Council meeting on June 22, 2026 by using e-comment (on website) until 4:00 p.m., by emailing cityclerk@livermoreca.gov by 12:00 p.m. or by delivering to the City Clerk at 1052 S Livermore Ave by 12:00 p.m. the day of the meeting.
2. In-person comments may be provided at the Civic Center Meeting Hall, City Council Chamber, 1016 S. Livermore Avenue, Livermore, CA 94550.

Public comments are limited to 3 minutes; and the Mayor may reduce the amount of time based on the number of persons wishing to speak.

Staff report and the recommendation for both public hearing items will be available for review in the City Council agenda packet from the evening of June 16, 2026, which can be found on the City of Livermore website at www.livermoreca.gov/agenda. If you challenge the item in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing, or in written correspondence delivered at, or prior to, the public hearing. Note: if these actions are subject to the Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.5, and you choose to challenge these actions in court, you must seek judicial review within the time specified in the Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.6.
